

Let's draw our watershed!

Now that you've learned what's in a watershed, draw your own watershed below. Think about local waterways (creeks, rivers, lakes etc.), landmarks, and other unique areas in your community. Refer back to your list on page 1 of the worksheet for more ideas!



- **Imagine a big rainstorm or windstorm. What might happen to one of the above pieces of litter if it stays on the ground in the watershed during a rainstorm or windy day? Would it stay in the same spot? Is there something else that might happen?**

Now, return to your amazing drawing of a watershed and add some of your litter examples to it!

Final reflection: Let's wrap up and reflect back on what we learned!

- **What is the nearest waterbody to where you live? This could be a creek, river, lake etc.**

- **Where might an item of litter near your home end up if it is blown away by the wind? i.e. the river down the street, a nearby park and into a storm drain, Lake Ontario, etc.**
